

Marine Safety Information: (P/C Alfred J. Fabbrini, SN)

New method for production of electricity on your boat – Dicknson Co. has developed a method to make electricity from Sumbrella plus fabric boat tops; the Sumbrella material contains photovoltaic cells that can be activated by sun light to produce up to 100 Watts of power transferable to your boat's battery. The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) – which went into effect in 1970 – requires that a federal agency should complete an environmental impact statement (EIS) on structures such as bridges, and others including ATONS before any building, repairs, or refurbishing work is done. If the EIS findings show significant impact on the environment, approval is granted. How does this policy affect the DBSPS? Safe boating is closely related to safe waters; carefully survey your area of responsibility (AOR) – especially after a storm or hurricane - and report any discrepancy to the nearest federal agency, Army Corp of Engineers, or the nearest Coast Guard station






