The Meeting was called to order at 1915 hours.

Secretary Report: (No Report)

Executive Officer's Report: (Lt/C Brian Crusan, P.)

We still need someone to volunteer for our Administrative Officer position. There are several places being looked at for meeting locations, such as, Hooligan's in Port Orange and the Hooligan's on ISB, Hwy 92, soon to open. Captain Daddy's is our meeting location for 21 April and Red Lobster on ISB on 19 May. Brian Crusan has been looking into a Squadron outing aboard the New Smyrna Beach River Boat for a Sunday afternoon dinner cruise on 12 June at a very reasonable price of \$20 each.

Other Activities: July - Martins, August - Little Tomoka YC, September - Hooligan's, plus a 24 April Fish Fry at Inlet Harbor from 1100 to 1500, baseball game on 29 April and we need to ask the membership at the membership Meeting on 21 April.

Education Officer Report: (Lt/C. William Benny SN.)

We have several courses now scheduled: ABC Class is scheduled for 4 & 11 June 2016 to follow National Safe Boating Week. A Piloting Class is scheduled to begin 7 June on Tuesday evenings from 7 to 9 PM.

These costs were approved by the Executive Committee as a sound investment in public outreach. Advertising for these events needs to be planned.

It has taken quite a bit of work to accurately determine Squadron overall budget requirements, state tax liabilities, etc. Further, the Squadron has not done a comprehensive inventory since the last in 2013 and one is overdue. Without a comprehensive inventory and value, a comprehensive accounting of Squadron accounts and assets is not possible. Also, the Squadron's long standing Scott Trade Account has been just languishing and only preserving capital and not generating any interest. The Squadron needs to decide how it wants to handle this account and what it's goals for this account actually are.

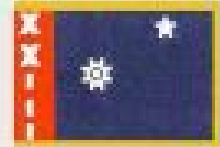
