

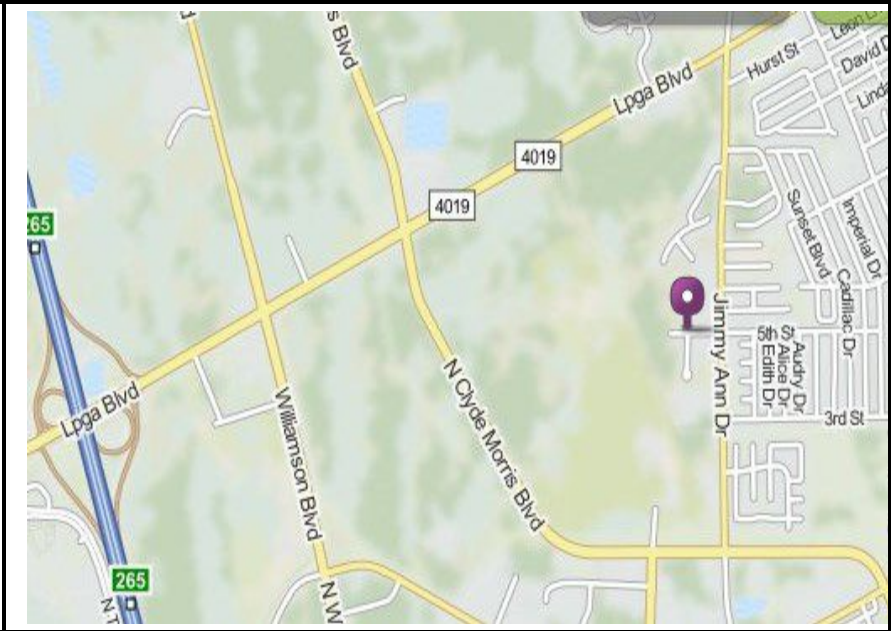

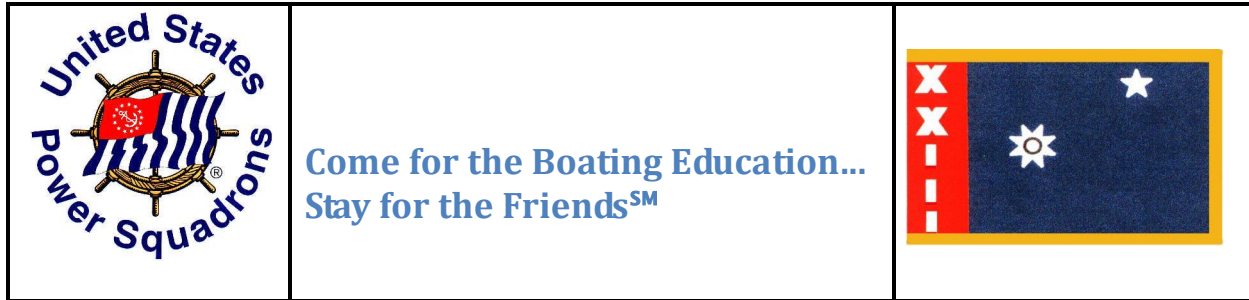
D23's 2016 Training Meeting & Winter Council
